2024 Oktoberfest Cancelled

After an expanded Oktoberfest Planning Committee meeting on August 1st, to which members were invited to attend, it is with deep regret we announce the cancellation of our 2024 Oktoberfest at the Vigo County Fairgrounds on September 20 and 21st. This decision was not made lightly, especially considering the rich tradition of this annual festival, which has been a staple in the Wabash Valley for decades. This marks only the second cancellation of an Oktoberfest fest in the Club's long history.

Despite several months of diligent work and the tireless efforts of the planning committee, volunteers and partners, unforeseen logistical and work force issues arose that prevent the Club from hosting this event to the standard which attendees expect and deserve. The satisfaction of our guests has been and remains the Club's top priority, and under the current circumstances, the Club could not guarantee this critical element.

However, in order to still celebrate Oktoberfest, the Club will host an authentic German dinner and dance on **Saturday**, **09/21/24**, at **6:00 PM**. Music will be provided by the Streamliners. More information about this event, which will be open to guests and the public, will be provided in the next newsletter.

The Club remains committed to preserving, promoting, and celebrating the Wabash Valley's strong German history, culture, and traditions. We are going to use this time to regroup, build our membership base, plan some new events, and prepare for a vibrant festival in 2025.


